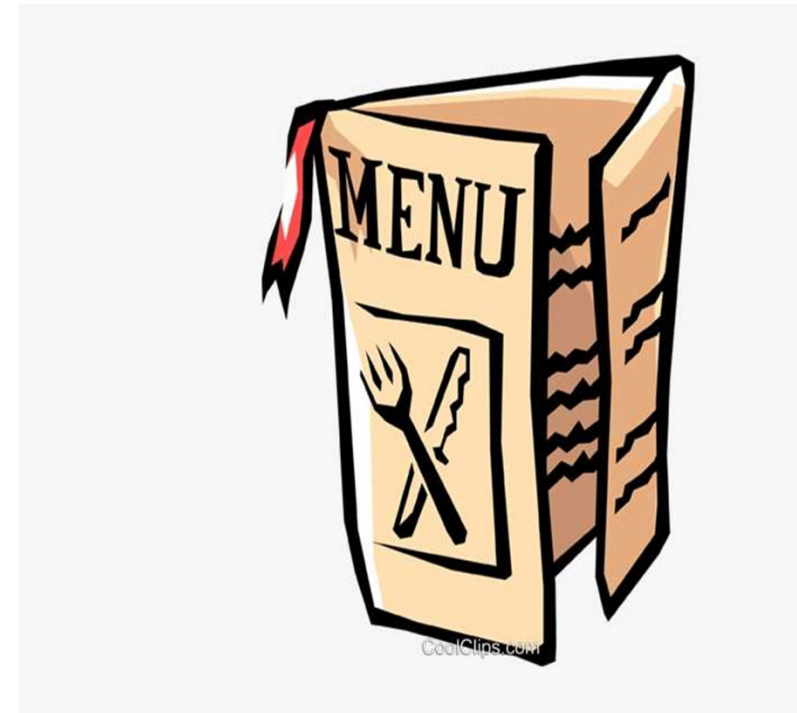

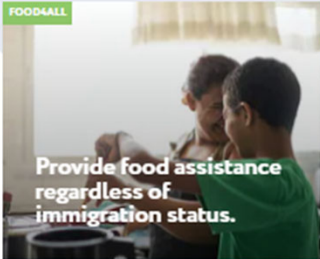

President Biden recently announced his [framework](#) for the Build Back Better Act. The legislation includes a \$10 billion investment in child nutrition that would

- Increase the number of schools that can offer free meals to all students through the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP)
- Give states, including California, the option to offer free breakfast and lunch to every student by implementing CEP statewide
- Bring Summer EBT to California — and expand it nationwide — for students who receive free or reduced-price school meals

Please urge your members of Congress to pass the Build Back Better Act with critical funding for child nutrition.
