<p>1.19 Recruit approximately 6-10 youth from two or more eligible schools or community based organization to lead a Youth Participatory Action Research (YPAR) nutrition and/or physical activity promotion project in their school or community. Guide participating youth through selection of school or broader community-based initiative. Facilitate research/evidence gathering component, development of presentation skills, and coordinate documentation and presentation of YPAR materials and events.</p>	<p>Increase opportunities for structured physical activity for students and their families.</p>	<p>Leader</p>	<p>Engage youth from the Boys and Girls Club to come up with a system for increasing utilization of the physical activity classes available to club members.</p> <p>Implement a club wellness policy.</p>
<p>3.8 Train staff from two qualifying healthcare clinics serving the Medi-Cal population on ways to incorporate the Rethink Your Drink (RYD) message when seeing patients and emphasize making healthier beverage choices.</p>	<p>Healthy food and beverage policies</p>	<p>Connector/Team Expert</p>	<p>Provide input on the best way to incorporate RYD messages into patient rooming procedures. Possibly pilot program in medical office or connect to other providers that would be interested in piloting program.</p>
