Key Elements of PSE Change	Answers to questions
1. Define the problem and your goal(s)

2. Understand the PSE Landscape	
How would understanding the PSE landscape be beneficial to your project?	
If known, what were the outcomes of past attempts to address the problem? What worked or didn't work and why?	
What actions will you take to understand the PSE landscape?	



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3. Outline a Clear Strategy for Change

What is your strategy for accomplishing your goal?

What steps will you take?

What is your timeline?

4. Mobilize Partners

What types of partners will you seek out to support your intervention?
Who are your potential partners?

If you have partnerships already established, how can they support your PSE change initiatives?

What actions will you use to mobilize partners?



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5. Educate the Public and Key Decision-Makers

What actions will you take to educate the public and key decision makers?
Examples could include: Media, identification of a champion, testifying, or advocacy campaign.

6. Determine Whether Success Has Been Achieved

How will you know when you've achieved your goal? How will you plan to measure success?

What interim outcomes are relevant to know if your project is on track?

What actions will you use to determine whether success has been achieved?

7. Take Stock and level Up

What actions will you take to share any lessons learned or successes from your project?

How to envision using this informing your work moving forward?
