


Sovernment Hierarchy



Outline of an Effective Advocacy Meeting

Prepare:

- Determine whether it should be in person or virtual
- Be clear about your ask
- Determine who should attend
 - Identify appropriate spokespeople
- Draft talking points/elevator pitch

Outline of an Effective Advocacy Meeting

Dos:

- Introduce yourself and tell your story (be brief)
- Share your experience
- Be mindful of industry jargon and acronyms
- Consider bringing appropriate materials to leave behind

Outline of an Effective Advocacy Meeting

Don'ts:

- Belabor the point
- Expect a vote commitment
- Discuss political activity/giving (ethics violation)

Follow-up

- Send a thank you
- Offer to be a resource for other information
- Circle back on the ask
